The ESU is a not-for-profit educational charity registered in Queensland and is part of a worldwide network of branches of ESU.

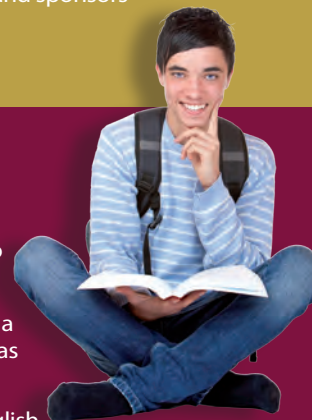
